 - Current Representative Member (12 countries)
 - Korea, Japan, Australia, New Zealand, VietNam, Sri Lanka, Malaysia, India, Nepal, Pakistan, Mongolia, Taiwan,

3. Hyang Sook Yoo (KWSE,former APNN chair) proposed more active in building the network among APNN members . Agreed to develop four programs and responsible team :

- 1. Exchange/visiting program (WSTEM)
- 2. Empowering/education program (KWSE)
- 3. Gathering program (TWiST)
- 4. Gender equality/governmental act (WE-Malaysia and Vietnam)
