The abstracts should be not more than 500 words, typed in Times New Roman 12 pt in size and single spaced. The abstract should contain four or five keywords, describing the work. Abstract should contain a clear title and affiliation of the authors. Margins should preferably be - left 2cm, right 2cm, top 2.5cm and bottom 2cm.
